

# Cathedral Windows by Machine

- 1¼ yards Fabric **A**
- ¾ yard Fabric **B**
- ¾ yard Fabric **C**
- Thread to match background fabric for piecing.
- Invisible or thread to match fabric A.
- Sewing pins.
- Sewing machine in good working order.
- Machine needles in standard size (80/12)

## Prepare before class:

Fabric **A** is for turning - this color sits between the inserted squares and the background fabric –you will see smallest amount of this color, yet it requires the most yardage.

Cut Fabric **A** into 72 rectangles: 6½” x 3½”

Fabric **B** is for the background and binding. The background looks like long oval shapes and appears behind the turned fabric and the inserted fabric.

Cut Fabric **B** into 72 squares: 3½” x 3½”

Fabric **C** is for the square inserts and border. This fabric will show the most visibly on your project.

Cut Fabric **C** into 27 squares: 3½” x 3½”
